

NAME

CURLOPT_NOBODY – do the request without getting the body

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_NOBODY, long opt);
```

DESCRIPTION

A long parameter set to 1 tells libcurl to not include the body-part in the output. For HTTP(S), this makes libcurl do a HEAD request. For most other protocols ie means just not asking for transferring the body data.

DEFAULT

0, the body is transferred
